

TREATS FOR SANTA PLATE



MATERIALS

CCX151 10" Coupe Dinner Plate Detail Brush Small Sponge on a Stick Medium Sponge on a Stick Waterbased Marker Treats for Santa Silkscreen Thickened Licorice Goo Screen Squeegee

COLORS

CMM 27 – Kiwi CMM 90 – Red Hot CMM 31 – Licorice

INSTRUCTIONS

If you're doing these plates for an event, we recommend silkscreening the pattern on all of the plates before the event. Then on the day of you can have the kids do their name and the spots.

- 1. Use your thickened Licorice "goo" and screen squeegee to apply the silkscreen to the plate.
- 2. Use a water based marker and have the child write their name under the hand.
- 3. Add your spots. Use Red Hot on your medium sponge dabber, and Kiwi on your small sponge dabber. We just did one coat on each.
- 4. Finally, trace over the kid's name with Licorice paint.

TIPS

- Tap off the excess paint from your dabber when you first dip it in.
- Make sure your Licorice "goo" is the thickness of pudding before you apply the silkscreen.
