CASSEROLE PUN PLATE



MATERIALS

DB24807 Geometrix
Large Square Plate
NCR Pattern
Red Pen
Liner Brush
Medium Round Brush
Detail Brush
Fan Brush

INSTRUCTIONS

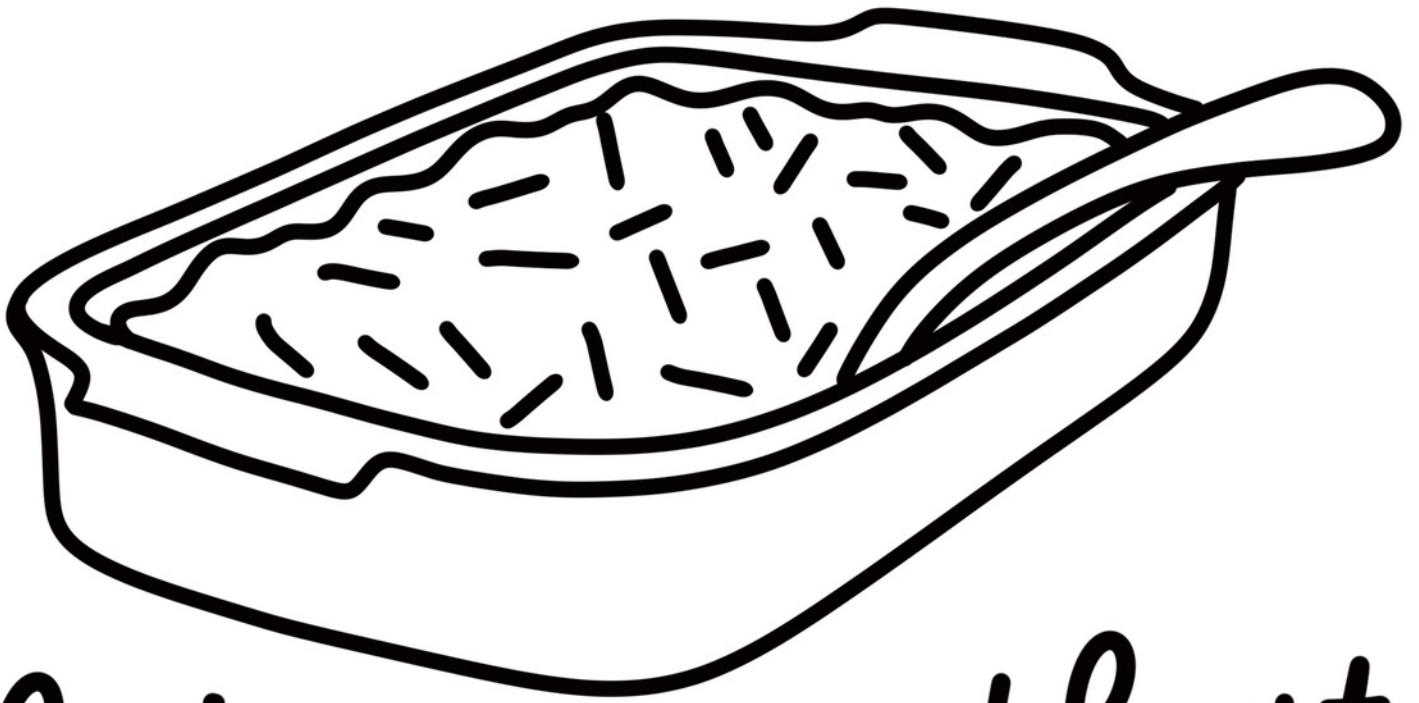
1. Thin down Sahara by adding 50% water to 50% paint. Load up the fan brush and sweep it back and forth across of the plate. Add a second layer.
2. Thin down Mocha Java by adding 50% water to 50% paint. Dip the medium brush into the paint. Pull the bristles back and flick the paint on the top of the plate. Allow the plate to dry.
3. Trace on the NCR pattern to side of the mug. Use a red pen to firmly trace over all of the lines. Before you remove the pattern, hold it in place on the corner and peel back the pattern to check and see if you've traced on all of the lines.
4. Use a detail brush to apply 2 coats of Cranberry Sauce to the top layer of the words.
5. Paint 2 coats of Pumpkin Pie to the second layer of the words using a detail brush.
6. Use a medium brush to paint 3 coats of Snowflake to the rim of the dish.
7. Next, fill in the outside of the dish and the inner section of the dish with 3 coats of Banana Boat.
8. Thin down both Sahara and Honeycomb with 50% water to 50% paint. To fill in the casserole, load up the brush with the watered down paints and drop the paint into the section. Then, use the tip of the brush to gently move the paint around, allowing the colors to blend.
9. Dip the end of the detail brush into Mocha Java and tap in dots of brown to look like the browned bits on the casserole.
10. Use a medium brush to paint in the spoon with 3 coats of Mocha Java.
11. Paint in the next layer of words with 2 coats of Olive You using a detail brush.
12. Use the detail brush to paint in 2 coats of Blue Green to the last layer of words.
13. Thin down Mississippi Mud with 50% water to 50% paint. Use a liner brush to outline the design.
14. To paint the edge, dip the side of the sponge into Cranberry Sauce . Tap off the excess paint onto a paper towel. Gently swipe the sponge on the edge of the plate to create a rim. Allow the first coat to dry and repeat.

TIPS

- The harder you push on the brush, the heavier the line will be. When you're using the liner brush, use the tip of the brush and very light pressure.
- Make sure to tap off the excess paint from the sponge to control the line of paint.
